Call for input for publication

Folder and File name: Please name the folder with the date_your_organisation name_your name and each contributed document with year_author_title.

Documents: As far as possible in MS Word format. This helps ERIG to put all input in a common layout before publishing. If not possible, pdfs are also accepted (will be subject to layout changes to fit overall graphic identity).

The deadline is September 15th, 2021. It is appreciated if you provide your input earlier.

Use of the scientific content

All content provided will be screened by ERIG office and if deemed fitting the suggested headlines evaluated according to the guiding principles of the “*ERIG Theses for the European energy future*”. Qualified contributions are consolidated and published in the scientific dossiers. ERIG will put the content in an overall layout.
